

SEEK OPTIONS NOT DEBT Know the Facts!

Statement #1 -The bond is \$161.5 million but when you include interest and the old bond the total is \$419 million over 30 years.
(GISD Exhibit C)

Statement #2 –The bond on the ballot must read a “property tax increase”. It is not a “rate” increase; a rate increase will likely follow.

Statement #3 - One elementary school is at capacity and the other schools are below capacity. The Admin building could immediately relieve any capacity burdens.

Statement #4 - 56% of GISD students are considered “economically disadvantaged students.” Why burden families with this debt for the next 30 years.

Statement #5 - The demographic study was the same study GISD used for the original bond for \$394 Million and the second \$151M failed bond last fall. The data is outdated and not correct.

Statement #6 –The last 2 years the student population growth is below the projected growth. The Superintendent stated growth has “plateaued”.

Statement #7 –The Administration Building was a school designed for 500-600 students.

Statement #8 – Some experts state that school choice will pass and will almost immediately reduce the Texas ISD population by 10%.

Statement #9 – Remember the airplane debacle.

Statement #10 - The Appraisal District returned \$1.030 M to GISD.
